Subject: Rental subsidies and deductions

Reasonable maximum rent levels for New York

- 1. The purpose of the present circular is to inform staff members that revision has been made to the reasonable maximum rent levels for eligible staff at United Nations Headquarters, which were announced in information circular ST/IC/2000/90. The current revision is based on the data collected for New York which form the basis for comparison of rents at other headquarters and similarly situated duty stations in Europe and North America.
- 2. The revised reasonable maximum rent levels for New York, effective 1 April 2007, are as follows:

Family size	Number of bedrooms	Rent (United States dollars)
Staff member alone	1	2 900
Staff member with spouse	2	4 727
Staff member with 1 child	2	4 727
Staff member with 2 children	3	6 500
Staff member with 3 or more children	4	7 200

3. The present circular cancels and supersedes annex VI of information circular ST/IC/2000/90 of 5 December 2000.
